

WSA Memorial Day Five-a-Side Rules

1. Tournament Headquarters- Camas High School, Cardon Field (turf)
2. Teams should check-in at Tournament Headquarters 30 minutes before their first match.
Please bring Tournament Roster, player cards with picture , signed and approved team roster, and travel papers if from outside Washington.
3. Boys and Girls U9-U18. Maximum roster size is 9, with up to 3 credentialed guest players allowed.
4. Teams will have Home and Away games. In the event of uniform conflict, Home team will change.
Parents and spectators shall remain in the Stadium stands.
No chairs or insta-benches allowed on turf or track.
Canopies may be set up (no stakes) over permanent benches, which shall remain on track.
NO WARM-UP ON TRACK. Use small spaces between fields away from goals for controlled warmup.
Players and coaches from both teams are on the same sideline.
5. Player card with picture will be checked by referee at all matches. Player number must match roster number.
6. FIFA rules apply except as modified for Futsal 5v5, and mini-goals, as follows:
2 x 23 minute halves, 5 minute halftime all ages.
Fouls- 5 team fouls, then PK for each additional foul.
Voluntarily leaving feet is a foul. Playing ball while on ground is a foul.
Minimal contact allowed. Game is about skill, not “combat”. Dangerous play is called much tighter, including lunging/stretching out into vulnerable position.
Fouls in the penalty zone will be a penalty kick.
Pass backs to the goal keeper that are handled will result in PK from spot.
For ball out of bounds- Kick-Ins taken at place ball went out.
ALL KICKS ARE INDIRECT EXCEPT FOR PENALTY KICKS. PK SPOT 6 YDS FROM GOAL.
Defenders minimum 8’ back on kick-ins, free kicks, corner kicks, and kick-offs.
Ball out of bounds over goal line is either corner kick or keeper throw.
Keeper may not dribble out for restart after ball crosses goal line.
Keeper throws or plays ball on ground only- no punts.
Kickoffs may be played back.
No Offsides.
5 second rule will apply to game restarts, (free kicks, goal keeper possession, kick-ins)
For fields 3-6 (mini-goals), GK MAY NOT use hands; they can use their hands/arms ONLY in front of their body, for protection from shots to the body or head, for knock-down only.
Fields are numbered 1-6 from South to North (left to right facing field from stands).

Fields 1-3 are “full sized” goals for Futsal. Fields 4-6 use “mini-goals”. Fields are “staggered”, with touch-lines marked along existing football lines on turf.

Goal Sizes

6’7”H x 10’W Futsal goal (U9) for use with full GK

Mini goals- “Sweeper/Keeper”- hands/arms for protection only.

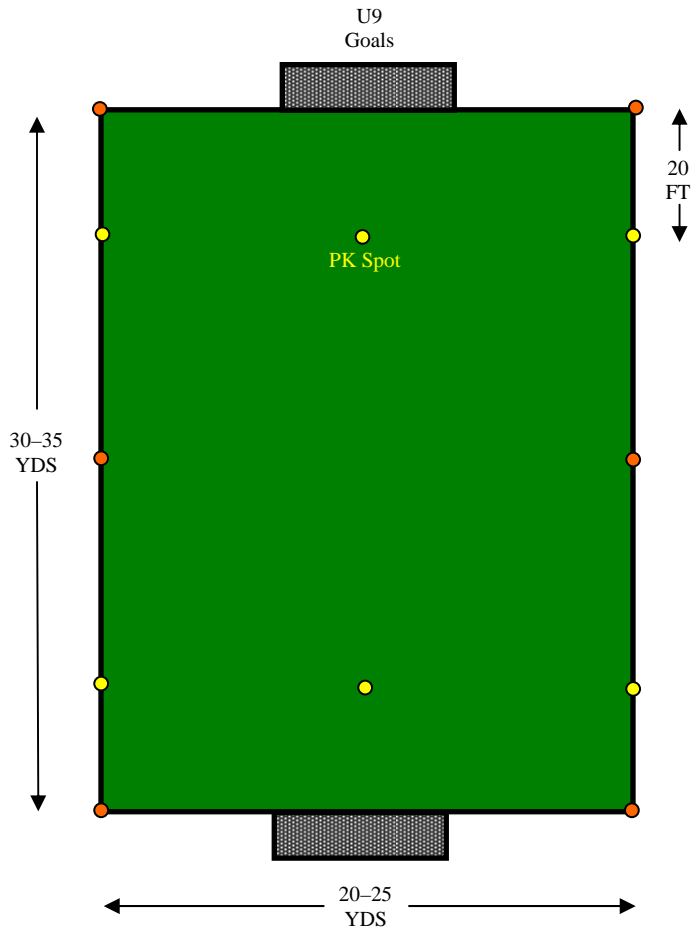
7. Substitutions on the fly from middle of field. Substitute players should wear training vests to designate not in play.
Shin guards are required. Soft casts must be approved by Tournament Director & Referee.
8. U-9 & U10 teams will play minimum of 3 matches, in Jamboree format.
U11 and up- Teams will play a minimum of 3 matches. 2 Teams from each bracket will advance. Elimination matches will be played to determine Champions. For Elimination rounds, shots from the spot shall determine winner in drawn matches.
All matches will have referees.
In the event of lightning, the match schedule will be delayed by the Field Marshall.
9. Forfeit will be recorded when a team is 30 minutes late for scheduled match.
Forfeits will be recorded as 6-0. Minimum of 3 players required to start a match.
10. Standings will be calculated using a 10-point system as follows:
6 points for a win, 0 points for a loss, 3 points for a draw, 1 point for shutout, 1 point for each 2 goals up to 6.
Tie breakers to be determined as follows: Total points, Head-to-head, goal differential, goals scored, goals allowed, coin toss.
11. Referees are responsible for reporting scores to Field Marshall.
12. Referee decisions are final. The referees shall have total control of their fields during their assigned matches.
13. Each coach will be personally responsible for the proper conduct of their team, including players, parents, guests and staff, as well as himself or herself. Abusive behavior toward referees, opponents, tournament staff, etc. will not be tolerated, and are grounds for immediate individual or team removal from the tournament facilities. Coaches or players ejected will not be eligible for next match. Players accumulating 3 yellow cards will serve a one game suspension. Tournament Disciplinary Committee will adjudicate all disciplinary actions and protests, and their decisions will be final. Disciplinary actions will be reported to the State Disciplinary Committee.
Spectators- No pets, alcoholic beverages, smoking, verbal abuse, or profanity.
CSD Field Use Rules will be enforced. CSD rules are clearly posted at the site.
14. Match balls will be provided.
